Christmas Program Reminders

Monday, December 17th

Colder Weather:

Winter is here and so is the cold and unpredictable weather. As a rule of thumb, all students will go outside for at least part of recess. They benefit from the fresh air as well as the open space to run and play. PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE send in enough clothing for your child to be warm and comfortable. It's typically windy on the playground and extra layers are a necessity some days. Please be sure your children are sent to school with a winter coat and they take it to recess. Fleece and hoodies are nice for warmer weather, but they do not keep them warm in colder weather. Hats, gloves, and pants/leggings under skirts are a necessity.
