## **Ohio Immunization requirements for 7<sup>th</sup> grade**

**Attention:** Parents of current 6th graders.

2 REQUIRED vaccines.

For next school year (Fall 2018) incoming 7th grade students are required by the State of Ohio to have received a **Tdap vaccine** & a **Meningococcal (MCV4)** before starting school in August. These additional immunizations are being required due to the increase incidence of highly contagious illnesses in teens. Your child may have received these vaccines during their most recent Well-Check at their doctor's office. Please contact your child's doctor's office and find out if they need this immunization.

Please send in an up to date print out of all immunizations your child has received.
